#### **HSE Health Protection Advice**


The HSE's Health Protection Surveillance Centre has developed some new posters and information for schools and parents/guardians to help improve respiratory hygiene among children. Young children are at increased risk of contracting infectious diseases because they tend to cough and sneeze into their hands, they are grouped together in school and are therefore more exposed to many new germs, have immune systems that are not fully developed to fight germs and have personal habits that spread germs more easily such as rubbing eyes and putting things in their mouths.

These posters are now on display around the school and the key messages for children and adults are:

- 1. When you cough or sneeze cover your nose and mouth with a tissue.
- 2. Cough or sneeze into your elbow, not your hands.
- 3. Always remember to throw away your tissue into a bin!
- 4. Remember to clean your hands after coughing and sneezing.

The HSE Under the Weather website has been updated recently <a href="www.undertheweather.ie">www.undertheweather.ie</a> which provides information on managing common illnesses. This website focuses on reducing the use of anti-biotics and empowering people to self-manage simple illnesses such as colds, coughs, sore throats, ear aches, rashes and flu.

#### **Punctuality**

Following on from our successful initiative to promote school attendance, we would now like to draw your attention to the issue of **punctuality in school**. Our school day begins at **09.00** am, but the school yard is supervised from **08.45** am each morning to facilitate parents/guardians. It is very important that children come to school on time each morning and are ready to join their class line to begin the school day together. Pupils who are *regularly late* (as opposed to isolated incidences) can find it difficult to settle and miss out on important learning activities in the classroom. As you can appreciate, class teachers may not always be able to repeat a learning activity or task missed by a pupil due to late attendance. Similarly, all pupils should be collected promptly at the end of the school day at either **1.45** pm for all Infant classes or **2.45** pm for all classes from First to Sixth.

It is our school policy in *Scoil Chéile Chríost Rathmore N.S.* to monitor pupil punctuality and incidences of late attendance are recorded on the Aladdin system. Your co-operation is appreciated as we have your child's best interests at heart in terms of providing them with quality teaching and learning experiences in our school and establishing good habits early on in their schooling. Thank you for your support in this matter.
