Each one of us has a duty to protect children from harm and the Department of Education and Skills (DES) has published the Child Protection Procedures for Primary Schools (revised 2023) to give direction to school management and staff regarding the identification of and response to child protection concerns.
The Board of Management of Scoil Chéile Chriost Rathmore N.S has adopted these procedures as school policy. Please note that the Designated Liaison Person (DLP) in place for dealing with child protection concerns is the school Principal, Lucy Travers and the Deputy Designated Liaison Person (DDLP) is the Deputy Principal, Caitríona Lancaster.
The Board of Management has recently completed an annual review of our Child Safeguarding Statement and Risk Assessment. A copy of our school's Child Safeguarding Statement and Risk Assessment are on

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display in the school reception area and parents/guardians are welcome to read through a hard copy of the documents in the school office or read the documents on the school website.

Cineáltas (Kindness) Action Plan on Bullying 2023-2027

It is very important that we all feel safe and happy in our school. The Minister for Education and Skills, Norma Foley recently launched Cineáltas: Action Plan on Bullying 2023-2027 to prevent and address bullying in all its forms. Our children and young people are placed at the very heart of Cineáltas and this action plan aims to enhance the work that we already do to ensure that all children who attend our schools are kept safe from harm and that the wellbeing of our children is at the forefront of everything we do. The plan takes a whole education approach to addressing bullying and emphasises prevention, providing support to every school community, improving oversight and awareness and working together as a community with a renewed sense of partnership and Cineáltas towards each other.

We have received a Cineáltas Flag and Cineáltas poster to acknowledge the good work that we are doing to prevent and address bullying and to promote kindness, respect, empathy, inclusion, diversity and wellbeing in our school. The Cineáltas Flag will serve as a visible national symbol of our school community's shared commitment to be kind and to work together to prevent and address bullying. As part of the implementation of Cineáltas, the Department of Education and Skills (DES) will be publishing updated Bí Cineáltas procedures for schools to prevent and address bullying in the coming months with training being made available for all school staff, parents and board of management members. The members of our Student Council have raised the Cineáltas Flag in the school and will be working with Ms. Travers, Ms. Lancaster and Mr. Walsh to raise awareness among all the children in the school. As part of our whole school approach to promote positive relationships and a positive school culture in Rathmore N.S. which values kindness, empathy and integrity, we are launching the Spirit of Rathmore Monthly Award Certificates which will acknowledge and celebrate those children who have been nominated by their class teachers for some act of kindness they have shown in school.
