Online Safety Webinar - Don't be Mean Behind Your Screen







Dear Parents/Guardians

Thank you to our *Parents Association* who organised and sponsored a very informative *Parent Talk* on Tuesday 25th March in the school as well as *Online Safety Talks* for all the children in 4th 6th classes with psychotherapist *Paula O' Connor*. Paula spoke on the night from her experience as a psychotherapist and former secondary school teacher and emphasised the importance of parents/guardians having regular discussions with their children about online safety. Paula was very well received by both parents and the students in the school and provided a follow-up handout which has been shared with the parents of the school.

The Bí Cineálta Procedures to Prevent and Address Bullying Behaviour for Primary and Post-Primary Schools were published in 2024 by the Department of Education and Skills (DES) following a review of the Anti-Bullying Procedures for Primary and Post-Primary Schools 2013. They will come into effect from the start of the 2025/2026 school year and provide direction and guidance on measures to prevent and address bullying behaviour including cyberbullying in schools. Some of the key areas of change include:

- An updated definition of bullying behaviour based on Cineáltas: Action Plan on Bullying (2022)
- Increased partnership approach to preventing and addressing bullying behaviour
- Increased oversight
- A student-friendly version of the school's Bí Cineálta policy must also be developed.

A consultation process is underway with parents, students and staff of the school which will inform our new Bí Cineálta policy. Thank you for your co-operation.

Be Sun Smart!







All primary schools received a communication from the *Department of Education and Skills* (*DES*) which is attached regarding the importance of skin protection for children when playing and spending time outdoors in the sun, particularly from <u>April to September</u> when the UV index is high.

As part of the HSE's National Cancer Control Programme, in collaboration with Healthy Ireland and the implementation of the Skin Cancer Prevention Plan 2023-2026, schools are being asked to include a wide brimmed hat as part of the school uniform to reduce their exposure to UV radiation.

As we are likely to experience more days of sunshine as we move into April and the Summer term and with Class School Tours also taking place, it is recommended that children have an appropriate hat in school for sunny days and have sun cream administered at home before school.

We are currently liaising with our school uniform provider, *Richie Whelan* in Naas for the supply of crested bucket type sun hats in the school colours for purchase by parents/guardians and we will advise when these hats

Rathmore NS Boys Claim Historic Victory in Kildare Mini 7's Hurling Tournament

The Rathmore N.S. Boys Hurling Team coached by **Mr. Walsh** achieved a historic victory in the Kildare Mini 7's hurling tournament on Thursday, March 27th. Having topped their group in the qualifying tournament the previous week at Eadestown GAA, the Rathmore boys earned a spot in the final round of games, held at Éire Óg Corra Choill GAA grounds.

In the opening match of the final tournament, Rathmore faced a strong Gael Scoil Uí Fhiaich team from Maynooth. With just one minute remaining, Rathmore were leading, but their opponents scored a late goal to secure a 2-point win. Despite the disappointment of the narrow loss, the Rathmore boys quickly bounced back as they faced last year's champions, Gael Scoil Nás na Ríogh, in Round 2. Displaying resilience, Rathmore came out strong, scoring two early goals and securing their first win of the day. Their confidence surged as they next played Rathangan N.S., where they delivered an excellent performance in a dominant victory. This win set up a thrilling final game against St. Corban's B.N.S., where the stakes were high in a winner-takes-all showdown.

The Rathmore boys began the game with impressive determination and skill, quickly establishing an early lead that they never gave up. While St. Corban's did threaten the Rathmore goal on several occasions, the Rathmore goalkeeper and defence remained resolute. Rathmore dominated the midfield, and their forwards proved too much for the Corban's defence to handle. As the final whistle blew, the Rathmore boys celebrated their victory, proudly bringing the trophy back to Rathmore N.S. for the first time!
